Ski Club will be on **Wednesday** nights beginning **January 4, 2017** through **February 8, 2017**. The program guarantees five (5) trips on Wednesdays and is for skiers (**6th grade to 12th grade.**) The bus leaves the municipal pool parking lot promptly at **4:30 PM**. Skiers are asked to be present no later than **4:15 PM**. Weather permitting, additional trips to Brandywine may be available through The Parks and Recreation Department for an additional fee, otherwise skiers must find their own transportation to and from Brandywine for Wednesday night open skiing. It is suggested that the members eat something before boarding the bus for ski club.

No food, drink, gum, or candy is allowed on the bus. Cafeteria facilities are available at Brandywine at the skier's expense.

Skiers are asked to assemble for the trip home in the front of Brandywine at **8:45 PM**. We will leave Brandywine at **8:55 PM**.

Students are responsible for keeping track of time. If your child is not on the bus when it is time to leave the ski site, it will be your responsibility to pick him/her up from the ski site. The bus will return to the municipal pool lot at approximately **9:30 PM**. Make sure that your child has a ride home at that time. **What type of equipment is needed?** Skis, or snow board, boots and poles are needed and can be rented from Brandywine Ski Resort. Locker rentals are available for personal items. If you rent ski equipment, **YOU** are responsible for it.
